### Removing the Tire and Wheel Assembly from a vehicle using The LM-200-R2


- 1. Position LM-200-R2 under tire and wheel on the vehicle and raise lifting fork by pressing the top of the control rocker switch [UP].
- 3. Once the rollers have made contact with the bottom of the tire, release the switch.
- 4. Remove lugs & pull the top of the tire toward you and disengage wheel from the vehicle.
- 5. With the tire on the rollers back the lift away from the vehicle and lower the lifting fork.
- 6. With the tire & wheel assembly resting on the ground, roll the LM-200-R2 away from assembly.


It is not necessary to lift the tire & wheel assembly off of the LM-200-R2.


## Installing the Tire and Wheel Assembly on a vehicle using the LM-200-R2

- 1. With the tire & wheel assembly on the ground, position the LM-200-R2 so that the forks are beneath the assembly.
- 2. Press the top side of the control rocker switch [UP] to raise the lifting fork up to the proper installation height.
- 3. Rotate the tire and wheel on the rollers to align lug studs to the wheel.
- 4. Slowly raise or lower to exact position and push the top of the tire and wheel assembly forward to engage the stud and lug nut holes.
- 5. Install lug nuts and lower lifting fork.
- 6. Move LM-200-R2 from beneath vehicle before lowering lift to avoid damaging product.




## STEP #1 CASTER & LEG INSTALLATION









